



Membership of Restore Glasgow

Who can be a member?

Membership of Restore Glasgow is free.

Membership is open to anyone 18 or over who is committed to praying about human trafficking and encouraging others to pray, and to combatting human trafficking in Glasgow.

Members can vote at AGMs and other members' meetings to help direct Restore's activities and elect our Board. You don't have to be a member to come along to the monthly prayer meetings.

How to apply for membership

As per our constitution, if you want to become a member you should submit a request in writing to the Board. This can be done via our [website](#). The Board will consider your application at their next meeting and notify you in writing of its decision.

What we do with your personal information

We will hold your full name, address and any other contact details you provide, along with the date on which you became a member. We will keep this securely, in compliance with current data protection laws. If you withdraw your membership, we are legally required to keep a record of your name for six years.

How to end your membership

To withdraw your membership, you need to give a signed notice of withdrawal to the Board.

We may occasionally contact you to confirm you still want to be a member, in which case you would have 28 days to confirm your membership, otherwise your membership would end.

Members can also be removed from membership if a resolution to remove them is passed by at least two thirds of voting members at a members' meeting. The member would get the right to have their say at the meeting where their membership is going to be voted on.
